GUNS & AMMUNITION

All Firearms will be limited to .45 cal. or smaller with a barrel of 8 3/8 or less

Stock Gun—(Semi-Auto or Revolver) Standard out of the box stock factory guns, Porting, Scopes, Optical Sights or added weight are not permitted in this event. **No Factory stock Comps or added weight.**

(Adjustable Iron after market Sights are permitted)

Unlimited Gun—(Semi-Auto or Revolver) Any legal handgun may be used. Porting, Scopes, Optical Sights or added weight will be permitted in this event.

NO HIGH VELOCITY, MAGNUM OR JACKETED AMMUNITION

Targets

(6) 8" diameter falling Steel Plates set at 11yds.

Scoring

10 Points for each Plate Knocked Down Minus the total time used to fire all 36 rounds

Example 36 plates = 360 Total time used 33.25sec 360-33.25= 326.75

Safety Rules

All guns will be unloaded and Holstered or in a case until you are called to the firing line and given the command to load and make ready!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

Eye and ear Protection are REQUIRED

All Spectators must obey safety rules and the Range Officer's Instructions !!!!!!!!

Best Time used for Score

Awards will be based on the Lewis system, Awards will be given to the winning competitors for 1st place.
